MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO BE ABLE TO TAKE SUBJECTS Gr. 10
* MATHEMATICS: Learners who do not pass Gr. 9 Mathematics with 41% are not normally allowed to take Mathematics in Gr. 10-12, BUT, because of the shortened academic year in 2020, Gr. 10 learners in 2021 will have the opportunity to prove themselves with regard to Mathematics as a subject up to and including the mid-year examination. (Changing from Mathematics to Mathematical Literacy necessitates that Physical Sciences / Mechanical Technology / Civil Technology also be discontinued and replaced with another subject.)
* PHYSICAL SCIENCES: Gr. 9 Science mark must be above 41%. Mathematics is compulsory with Physical Sciences in Gr. 10-12.
* COMPUTER APPLICATIONS TECHNOLOGY: MUST have access to a computer to use at home
